There were approximately 100 people in attendance for the kickoff which had a magic show and treats thanks to Tara McMurtry. There are forty one children signed up for the eight week program. The online history archive was created and is running. Director Henkel plans to do a story on the project and make a public announcement. Ben from ESU installed the outside access to our fiber internet. The annual Western Library Systems meeting is August 1, 2023 at 9:30 a.m. and Library board members can attend.
