

The original town of Bayard was established in July of 1888. Bayard's most famous attraction is Chimney Rock, which is located 3 ½ miles south of town. Chimney Rock is easily one of the most famous landmarks of the Oregon Trail. In 1956, Chimney Rock was designated a national historic site by the federal Government.

On October 23, 1917, the Village of Bayard, through an ordinance became a second-class city to be governed by the Mayor and City Council.

The growth of Bayard had been very slow until 1917, when the Great Western Sugar Company built a factory near town. The population was 261 in 1910 and today is around 1200.

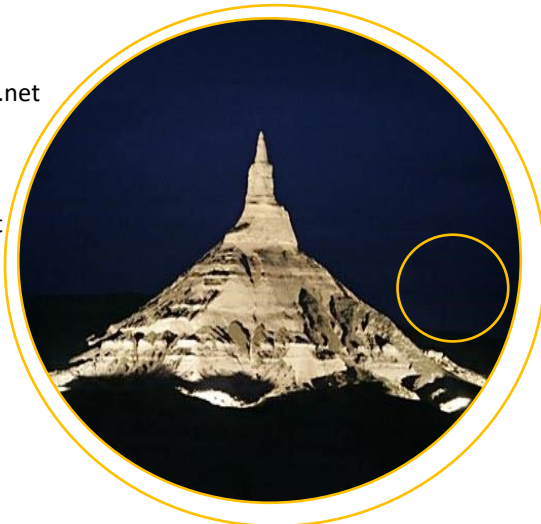

ATV & UTV Registration



ATVs & UTVs may be operated within city limits from sunrise to sunset; operator must have class O operator license, insurance, and obtain registration from the City.

ANIMALS

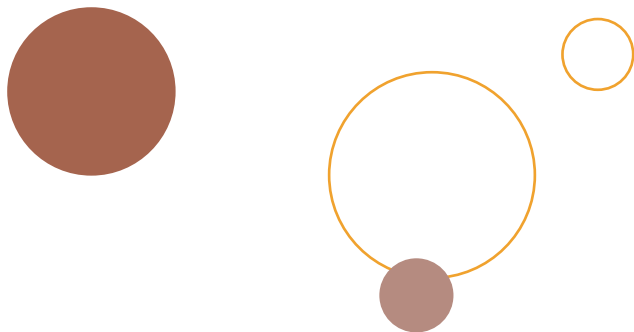
All domestic animals (dogs & cats) are **required** to be licensed within the City of Bayard. All licenses shall be issued in January with proof of rabies vaccination and fee set by City Council. There is a limit of three (3) animals within city limits.

All dogs shall remain within the residence at which they reside or be on a leash when not at the residence. Any dog that is found running free will be impounded and a fine could be assessed.

Owners of dogs must pick up dog waste. The city provides poop bags in both city parks for pick up within the park.

The city does **NOT** allow any livestock or any type of fowl within the city unless zoning districts allow such.

Feeding of feral cats is prohibited.



UTILITIES

City Utilities

The city provides water, electric, sewer and garbage. Bills are due by the 10th of each month. We accept multiple forms of payment (ACH, Credit/Debit Card, Cash, or Check). You can pay online at cityofbayard.net, call, or come into office at 445 Main Street.

Dump

The city has a dump area East of the High School, where you can pay to take large items. There is a charge for items that go out to the dump.
